I.K. Akhunbaev Kyrgyz State Medical Academy (KSMA) is the first medical university in Kyrgyzstan that accepted foreign citizens for study medicine. The first applicants studied in Russian in 1989 and in 2001 was introduced the training in English.

KSMA was established in 1939 and over the past 84 years there were trained and graduated more than 50,000 doctors and pharmacists who work in all corners of Kyrgyzstan and countries near and far abroad.

Today KSMA is the leader of higher medical education in Kyrgyzstan and one of the leading medical universities in Central Asia and the CIS, with rich experience and strong traditions in the training of medical and pharmaceutical personnel.

KSMA is running a Doctor of Medicine (MD) program for foreign students (which is equivalent to MBBS program in India & Pakistan). The duration of the training is 6 years (5 years of the main training and 1 year of Internship). Upon graduation from KSMA, students are issued a state diploma and a certificate of clinical training, allowing them to carry out medical activities as a general practitioner.

KSMA owns following clinical bases:

1. Diagnostic and Treatment Center of KSMA, Bishkek;
2. Educational Scientific Medical Center of KSMA, Bishkek;
3. High-Altitude Scientific and Medical Center at Tuya-Ashu;
4. Hospital in the city of Bishkek (for 300 beds) (Currently under construction);
5. Hospital in the city of Batken (for 100 beds).

In addition, by order of the Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic dated October 6, 2022, No. 1194, 287 healthcare organizations are used as clinical healthcare facilities of KSMA in the Kyrgyz Republic and clinical healthcare facilities abroad under the bilateral agreements.

KSMA is the only public higher medical university in the Kyrgyz Republic that provides life learning medical education starting from secondary school trainings up to the continuous education of practitioners. In this regard, KSMA is available to all state healthcare organizations for practical training and internships.
